The Team is very impressed with the speed of deploying the Cobra Cuffs compared to the past plastic flexible restraint systems. These systems were too rigid, bulking and cumbersome. The Cobra Cuffs are easily stowed in pouches on the Operator's kit with no worries of snagging or being pulled off the kit. This was a constant problem with the past systems. Also, we were impressed with the strength of the Cobra Cuffs. We ran many tests to defeat the cuffs which all failed. Again we are impressed and made the Cobra Cuffs our primary restraint system.
